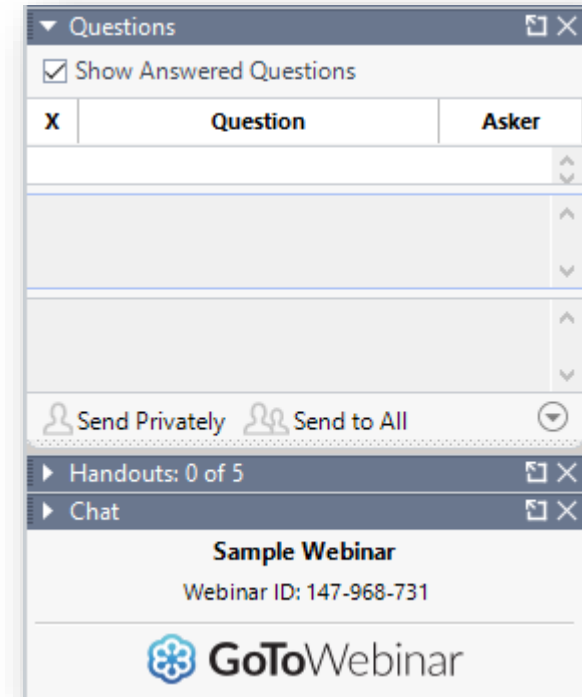

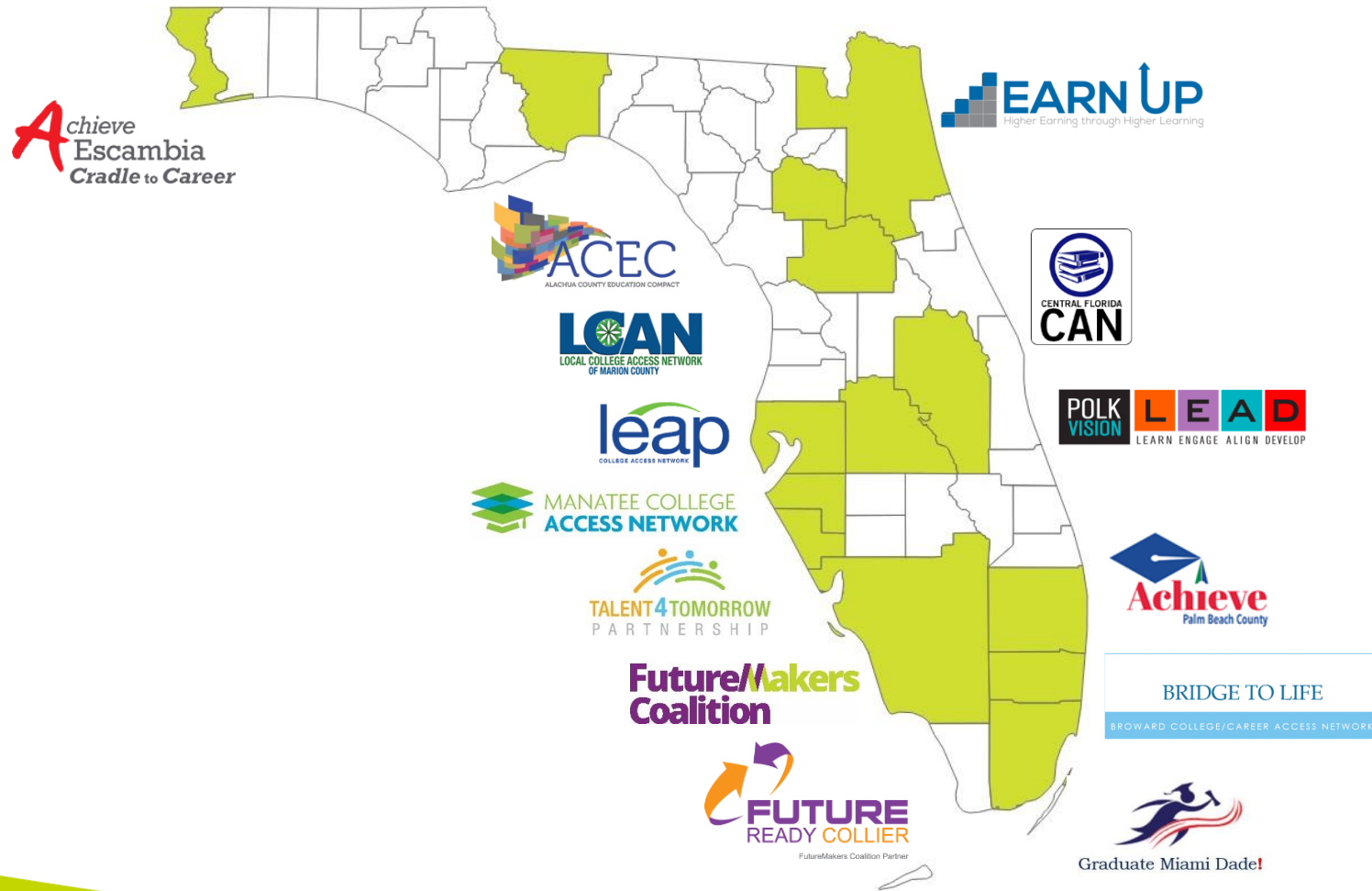


# Florida College Access Network

**Our mission:** To create and strengthen a statewide network that catalyzes and supports communities to improve college and career readiness, access, and completion for all students

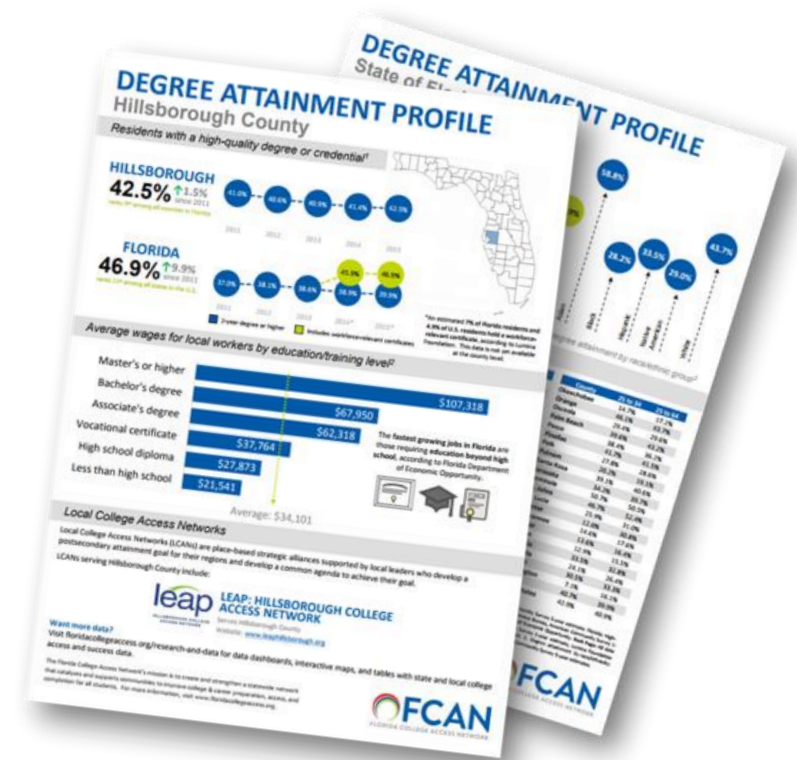
**Our vision:** At least 60% of working-age Floridians will hold a high-quality postsecondary degree or credential by the year 2025

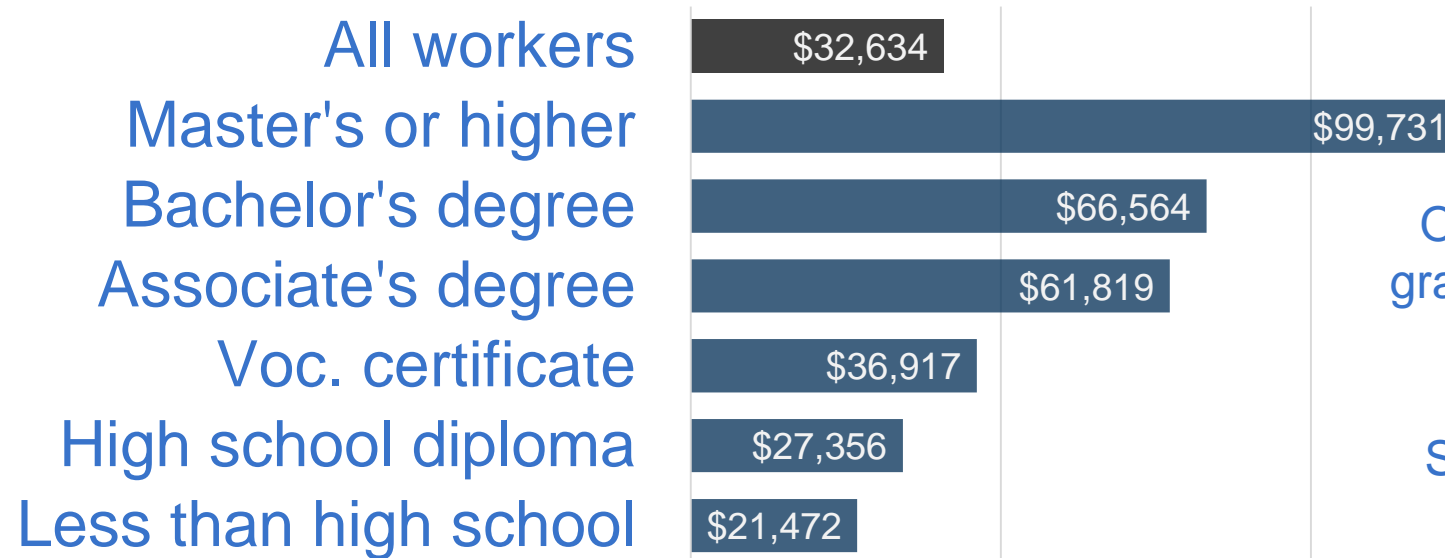

# Preparing Students for Life

Median annual wages in Florida by education/training level



Only about 50% of Florida's high school grads find employment by the following fall with 88% earning less than \$8/ hour

Students with postsecondary education not only make more money over the course of their lifetime, but are also less likely to be unemployed
