





Planning Checklist

- 


Discuss your post-high school plans.
 Talk with your parents, teachers, and school counselor about your plans for the future.

Review admission requirements.
 Review the admission requirements for the branch(es) of the military you are interested in. Military recruiting websites have lots of information available.

- 

Meet with a recruiter.
 Meet with a recruiter from each branch you are interested in. The recruiter can help you explore your options so you can make a decision.

- 

Apply.
 Apply for the branch you are interested in enlisting in. Applying is not a commitment to serve.

- 

Take the ASVAB test.
 Schedule with the recruiter to take the ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) test to measure your strengths and potential for success.

- 

Explore career options.
 Once your ASVAB results are available, explore career options with your school counselor and recruiter.

- 

Finalize your decision.
 Decide on the military branch you plan to commit to. Verify you meet all eligibility criteria with the recruiter. Find out the steps to commit.

- 

Notify your school counselor of your decision.
 Let your school counselor know of your decision, and find out if your school hosts a Military Signing Day. Plan on participating.
