

Contractors oversee construction-site work, often specializing in a particular type of project, such as residence, commercial buildings, or public works. Before starting a project, contractors estimate the cost of the project by studying building plans and looking at building materials and labor expenses. They then submit a bid to the individual or company that will pay for the project. If the bid is accepted, then the contractor begins the project. A contractor sometimes participates in the physical work but often supervises a number of subcontractors who are in charge of carpentry, plumbing, and other specific projects. General contractors ensure the delivery of materials and the completion of various tasks, keeping and eye on costs at all times. They communicate will their clients to inform then of the progress of each project.




