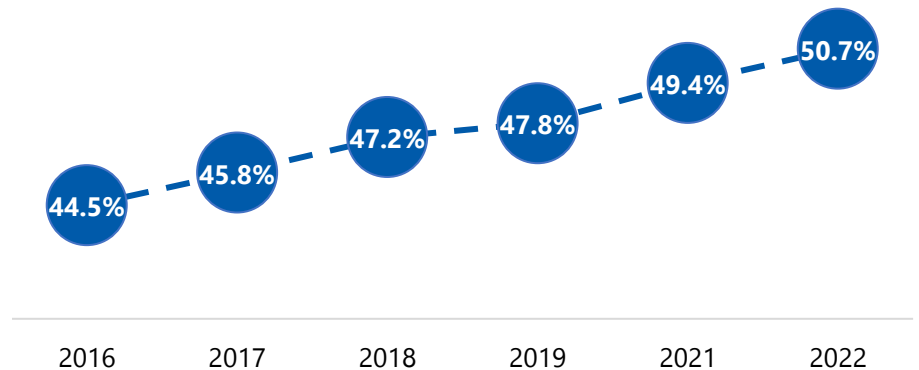

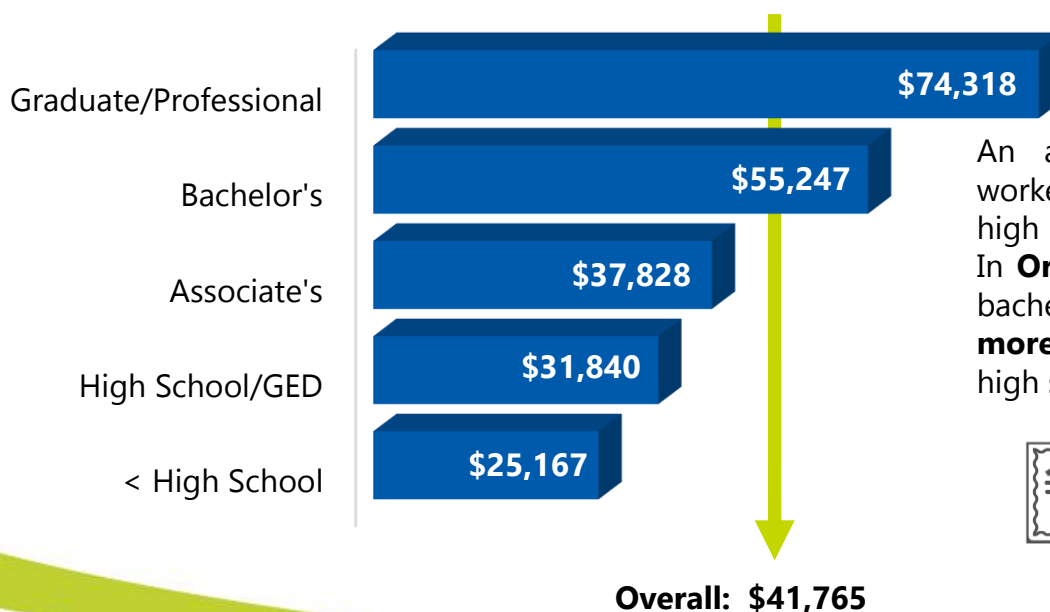

### Median Earnings by Education/Training Level
